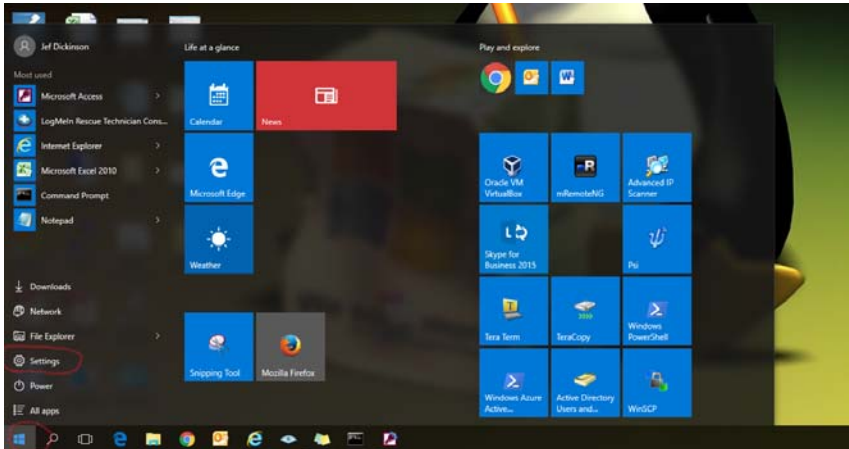


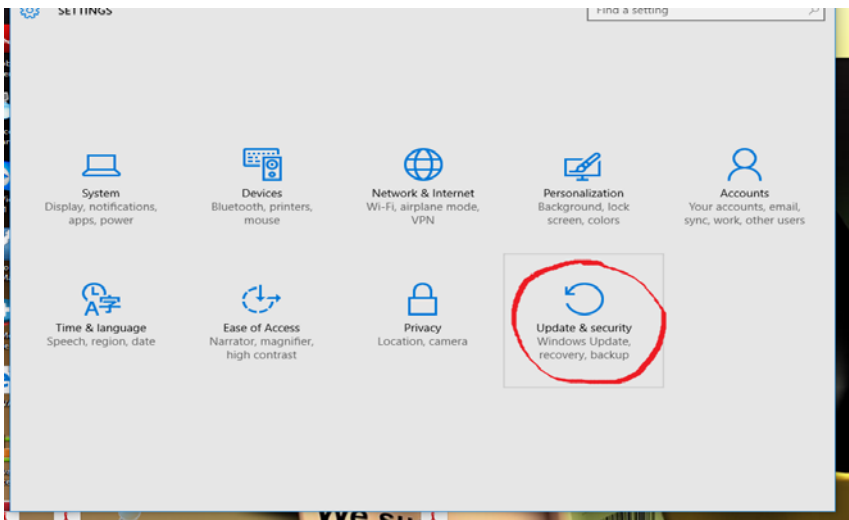
Change Windows 10 Update Settings

To change the Win 10 update settings, do the following:

Click on the Start Menu and select **Settings**

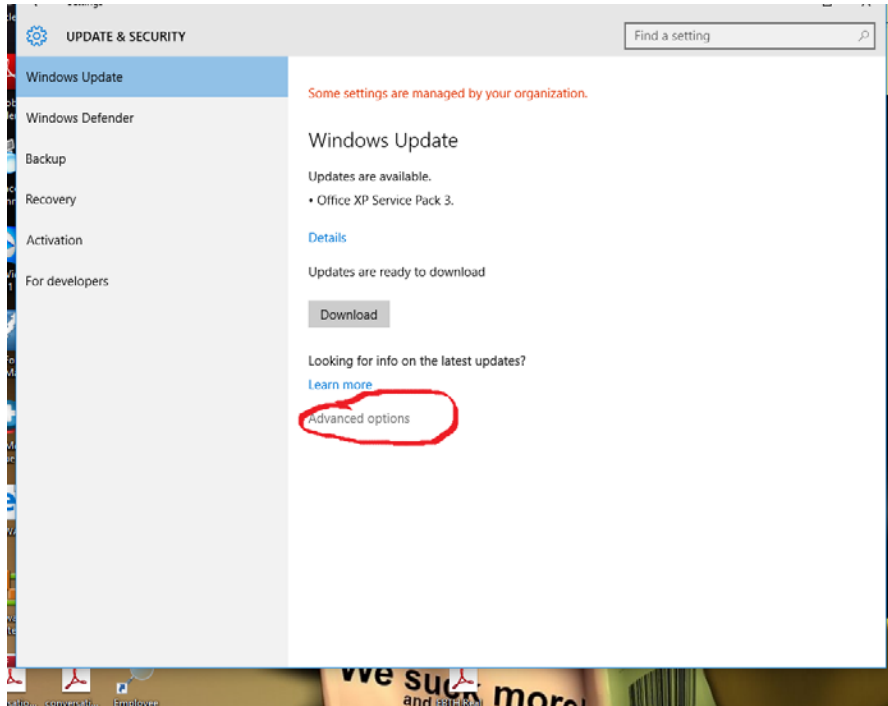


Next, select **Updates & Security**



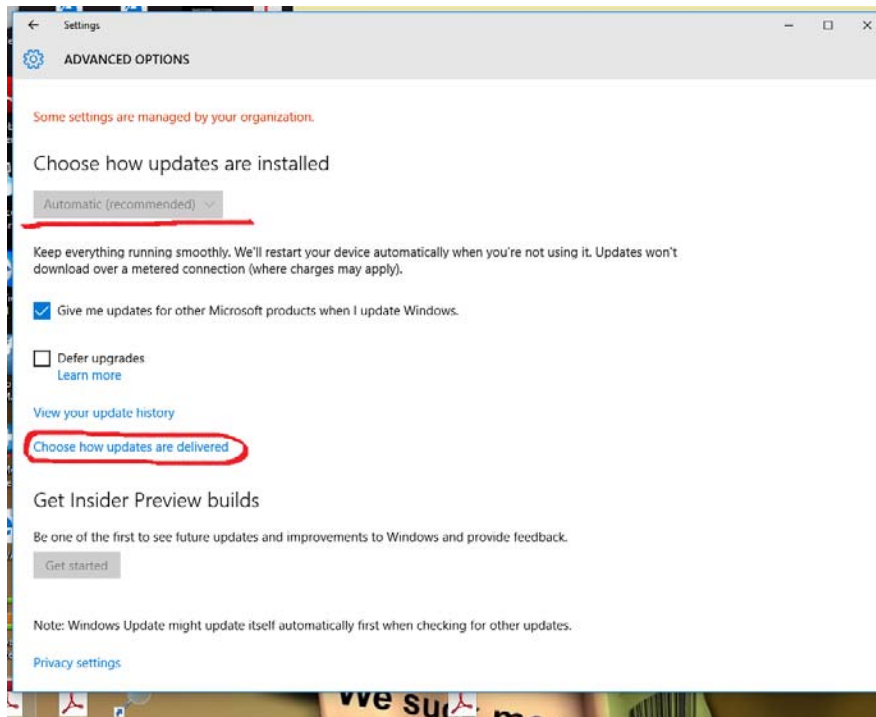
Change Windows 10 Update Settings

Under Windows Update, click on **Advanced Options**



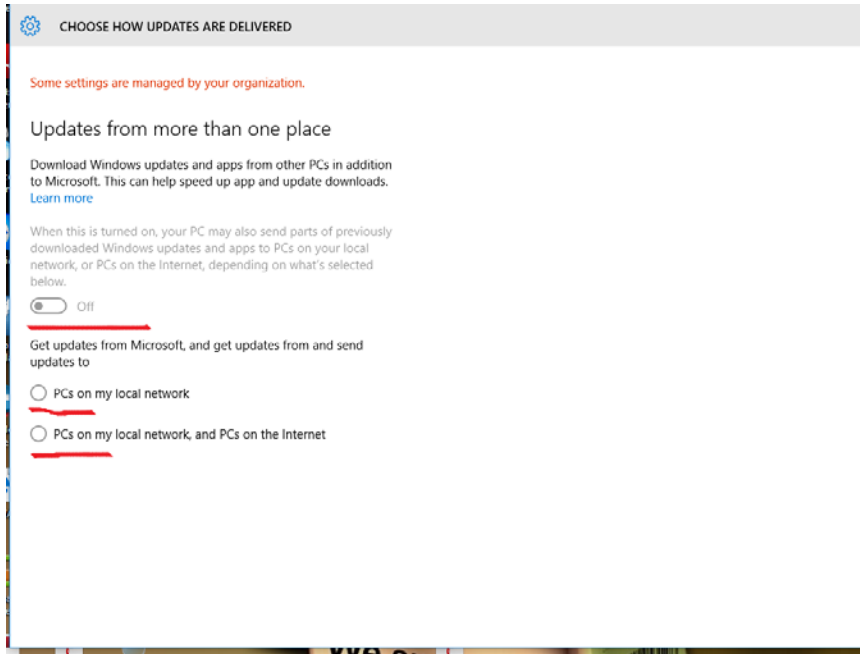
From here, you can select how the updates are installed. Once that is selected, click on

Choose how updates are delivered



Change Windows 10 Update Settings

On this screen, make sure the settings are set to what you see below.



When these items are selected, it causes Windows 10 to utilize an extreme amount of bandwidth as it tries to obtain updates through peer sharing; also a security risk. Again, make sure these settings are not checked or on just like above.

Next, you will want to set a metered connection; which will be the REO network:

Click on the Start Menu then click Settings...Select Network & Internet then Click WiFi

Select Manage Known Networks and choose REO and select Set as metered connection



This option will keep windows from downloading updates on the REO network, but will allow it on your home network without having to change anything.
